**PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM IMPACT FEES**

**ARTICLE I. IMPACT FEES**  
**(Rates Effective October 1, 2008)**

- A. There shall be an impact fee of \$546 for each metered water tap into a public water main and each pre-tapped meter set. This fee shall be the same regardless of meter or tap size. This fee is due and payable at the Athens Utilities Business Office concurrent with the payment of the water tap fees.
- B. There shall be an impact fee for all unmetered fire line taps according to the following schedule.

| 2" Tap  | \$ 546  |
| 4" Tap  | \$1,093 |
| 6" Tap  | \$1,639 |
| 8" Tap  | \$2,185 |
| 10" Tap | \$2,732 |
| 12" Tap | \$3,278 |
- These fees are due and payable at the Athens Utilities Billing Office as the first step in securing an unmetered fire line tap.
- C. Metered fire line taps shall be dealt with as other metered taps per Paragraph A. above.

**ARTICLE II. CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

All revenue from these impact fees shall be deposited in a Capital Infrastructure Fund for the Water Department to be administered by the Utilities Finance Director with disbursements from that fund only by resolution of the Athens City Council.

**ARTICLE III. INFLATION FACTOR**

Effective October 1, 2006, and annually thereafter, unless adjusted by Resolution of the Athens City Council, the impact fees established by this Ordinance shall increase three percent (3%).
